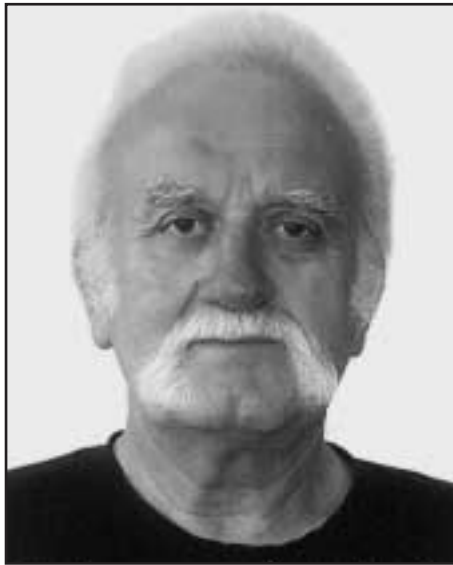

Dear Voter,

The questions below were put to me on the door-step whilst collecting signatures in Huthwaite, to enable me to stand for the County Council:-

Q. Who are you and why do you want to stand in Sutton West?

A. I am a public-spirited activist who cares deeply about justice and democracy. I am happily married, and one of my grown-up children who has Downs Syndrome still lives with us. I am a Nottingham born ex-coalminer and a biker with a conscience.

I wish to stand against the Leader of Nottinghamshire County Council who, in my opinion, is not fit for purpose. Decisions were made under his leadership that have made old ladies cry, because of the threat of their care home closing and disrupting their security.

Q. I've not voted for years. Why should I vote now? Aren't they all in it for themselves?

A. The only opportunity most of us have to influence local government is by voting for someone who will not be bullied into wrong decisions. We must use the vote that others sacrificed so much to give us. It is the party-political antics of only a few which have damaged the reputation of the many principled people who volunteer for public service.

Q. What can you do when you are just one person?

A. Think positively. Doing nothing is not an option. For example, I helped spearhead a campaign to prevent care home closures in Nottinghamshire with legal aid from Yvonne Hossack, Solicitor.

I am a founder member of three organisations:

- Nuthall Residents and Tenants Association, from whose ranks came Broxtowe's first female Independent mayor.
- Justice for Carers, which champions carers and the ones they care for, see www.justiceforcarers.org.uk
- KATCH-DC (Kirklands Against The Closure of our Home and Day Centre).

To combat vandalism we must give our youth direction and hope for the future, by providing good role models in families, communities and education. I am a networker with a social conscience and will always act in the best interest of the whole community. For example, I do not agree with turning "Bentinck Void" a former colliery site between Annesley Woodhouse and Selston into a rubbish tip.

David Chapman a resident in Kirklands Care Home says:

Kirklands is a wonderful, well-run County Council Care home in Kirkby-in-Ashfield, catering for people with dementia and the onset of Alzheimers. Our care staff are second to none and, with help from families and friends, we have generated a homely atmosphere; so why was our home going to be taken away from us?

Council representatives said new legislation demanded we have en-suite rooms. Kirklands was on a list for closure, and County Council leader Cllr Kirkham would not even come to talk to us about it.

*Grenville ran a successful campaign to stop the closure, and CSCI (Commission for Social Care Inspection) even upgraded our home from two star to three! **This is the sort of considered, careful and caring help we look for in a councillor and is typical of him.***
